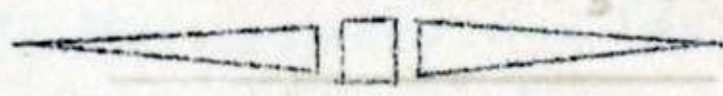

Aid for needy students can be expected up to 80 piastres a month, for which notes will be taken to be paid provided the giver of the note does not remain in the work for five years at least.

The College gives table board for 5- $\frac{1}{2}$  for nine months.

Room rent and tuition are free.

Each student furnishes his own bed and bedding, washing, fuel, lights, stationery, &c.

The Seminary has a well selected library of about 1500 vols., containing some of the best works. The reference department is full. It has many Armenian works. New books are constantly being added.



The language of the text books is mostly English, but Armenian and Turkish will be largely used in the class room.

Examinations will be held from time to time in the various subjects.

Diplomas will be given to those alone who satisfactorily complete the course.

Candidates must bring a certificate of church membership from their church and pass a satisfactory examination as to Christian experience and motives for entering the ministry.

All should be present at the beginning of the term.
