et à toutes les maisons de commerce intéressées dans
le commerce du Proche Orient**

New-York, le 1 Juillet 1919.

La Chambre de Commerce Américaine pour le Levant dont le siège se trouve à Constantinople, n'a pu pendant les dernières années de la guerre générale, se tenir en contact avec ses membres en Amérique. A cause de la censure sa publication trimestrielle, la LEVANT TRADE REVIEW n'a pu leur parvenir régulièrement. Cette publication si intéressante et si pleine d'importance pour les membres de la Chambre a cependant été publiée jusqu'à la fin de 1916. Mais tout était difficile au moment de la guerre, les communications même avec le Levant étaient des plus irrégulières quand elles n'étaient pas complètement interrompues.

Ce qui fait qu'en 1917 et 1918 le Conseil des Directeurs s'est vu obligé de suspendre ses activités et d'attendre la reprise de la vie commerciale. Mais dès Janvier 1919 ils ont tenu plusieurs séances et en Février ils ont offert une magnifique réception à l'Amiral Mark Bristol, Commandant les forces navales américaines en Orient. Les Directeurs se sont également occupés de la reprise du travail pour la Chambre de Commerce. Ils ont voulu être utiles à leurs membres de Constantinople, Smyrne, etc., en essayant d'obtenir pour eux des informations concernant les prix des marchandises du pays aux Etats-Unis, et les prix des produits américains pour l'exportation. Dès les premiers jours du mois de Mars la Chambre de Commerce Américaine aux Etats-Unis a été invitée télégraphiquement à co-opérer avec vous et à faire tout son possible pour établir entre les Etats-Unis et vous un commerce des plus actif et des plus important.

Dès que le blocus a été levé, en Février 1919, l'Amérique a été la première nation à reprendre ses relations commerciales avec la Turquie. De grandes quantités de farines américaines ainsi que du lait condensé ont été vendues sur le marché de Constantinople. Il en a été de même en Roumanie et en Bulgarie. D'autres produits américains ont aussi été expédiés de Grèce à Constantinople, ce qui a été d'un grand secours vu la cherté de la vie qui régnait alors à Constantinople.

L'exportation a immédiatement commencé entre le Proche Orient et les

Etats-Unis, car de grands stocks d'opium, tabac, d'essence de rose, mohair, réglisse, tapis, etc., étaient prêts pour l'exportation ce qui fait que ces marchandises ont pu être embarquées sur les bateaux américains des sociétés de Bienfaisance et de Ravitaillement pour leur voyage de retour. Ces bateaux battaient tous pavillon américain. Dans l'espace de deux mois des marchandises d'une valeur de plus de 10 millions de Dollars ont été expédiées de Constantinople, Smyrne, Samsoun, Batoum, aux Etats-Unis. Pendant ces deux derniers mois le port de Constantinople a vu plus de bateaux battant pavillon américain qu'il n'en avait vu pendant vingt années.

Un grand nombre des commerçants de Constantinople et des environs, qui ne sont pas encore membres de la Chambre de Commerce Américaine et qui sont intéressés dans le commerce avec les Etats-Unis, ont adressé leur demande afin d'être admis comme membres. L'opinion générale est que l'on peut entreprendre de grandes affaires en ce moment surtout quand il s'agit de la vente des produits américains en Turquie, Roumanie et Bulgarie.

Les marchés Grec et Egyptien qui étaient ouverts à l'Amérique pendant la guerre ont acquis une grande importance depuis 1914.

Il y a en ce moment plusieurs facteurs très importants qui tendent à favoriser l'exportation américaine en Orient. Tout d'abord l'Amérique pour des raisons politiques et humanitaires jouit d'une grande popularité dans tous les cercles et parmi toutes les races.

Deuxièmement nous avons acheté et achetons encore en Turquie plus que ne le fait aucune autre nation.

Troisièmement nous possédons maintenant les mêmes facilités de transport que la France et l'Angleterre; il y a aux Etats-Unis un crédit ouvert par la vente des produits orientaux et de la Mer Noire et les commerçants veulent employer ce crédit à acheter des produits américains.


Quatrièmement, il y a un secret espoir de voir bientôt une banque Américaine s'établir à Constantinople et dans les autres principaux centres, alors les exportateurs américains jouiraient tout de suite de certaines facilités financières.

Et pour conclure nous savons que tous les dépôts de marchandises et de produits manufacturés ont été épuisés pendant la guerre, ce qui fait que dès que la question politique et monétaire de la Turquie sera réglée il y aura de grandes commandes adressées en Amérique.

La LEVANT TRADE REVIEW va bientôt reprendre sa publication. Les avantages que vous retirerez par l'insertion de votre nom dans la liste des membres qui est publiée mensuellement dans la LEVANT TRADE REVIEW compenseront largement les frais d'insertion qui ne s'élèvent qu'à 10 Dollars par an.

Bulgarian Otto of Rose

The entire Bulgarian otto of rose crop has been taken over by the Government of that country and producers have been strictly forbidden to make any exportations. By an agreement entered into between the Bulgarian Government and the United States Food Administration (Grain Corporation), the population of Bulgaria will be supplied with food from America, payment to be made out of the proceeds of the Bulgarian crop above mentioned, the chief Bulgarian item of export to America. This procedure was deemed preferable to shipment of gold, which has been deposited at Constantinople in sufficient quantities to cover American food exportations.

The total crop thus commandeered has been transported to America in the joint custody of the United States Food Administration and a Bulgarian official, L. Getshoff, and its disposition was discussed at a meeting at the offices of the Food Administration attended by W. G. Ungerer, of Ungerer & Co., representing the product of Pappazoglou, and by representatives of Compagnie Morana and of Antoine Chiris, agents for Christoff and Shipkoff, respectively. Inasmuch as these three producers are representative of the entire Bulgarian otto of rose industry it was hoped that the conference would result in the most favorable disposition possible of the small available stock, not in any wise as a mercenary transaction, but as a means of most effectually coming to the succor of a people needing foodstuffs.

A lengthy discussion of the market in general terminated in the decision of the Bulgarian official that the present crop should be sold at a price lower than \$17.50 per ounce, considerably below the anticipations of Mr. Getshoff. It was at the same time pointed out that the distillation of the fall crop might effect no reduction of price, in view of the unsettled condition of affairs in the country of origin.

the total foreign trade of Roumania surpassed that of Greece, Bulgaria and Serbia combined. As a result of the war, Roumania will greatly increase her territory and population and the enlarged Roumania, made up of a population of the same nationality, will have at least 15,000,000 inhabitants, with an increased territory and increased natural resources.

Before the war with the exception of a share in the development of Roumanian oil production, the United States had little participation in the Roumanian markets, for Germany fully realized the importance of Roumania as a field for industrial and commercial exploitation and did everything in its power to maintain an economic control of Roumanian developments. Primarily an agricultural country, with the exception of her petroleum industry, Roumania was dependent upon other countries for the importation of manufactured articles, including general merchandise and machinery equipment. Germany and Austria combined furnished Roumania with about 59 per cent of her total importations.

To-day Roumania is looking for assistance in the rehabilitation of her industries. Roumania desires to prevent as far as possible any resumption of German domination, and, therefore, looks to American business interests for assistance and aid, mutually

beneficial for the development of her industrial and commercial organization. The United States, on account of the opening of the Dardanelles, has direct water transportation to Roumania to the port of Constanza, on the Black Sea, and is in a position to meet the requirements of the Roumanian market in the form of general merchandise, textiles, boots and shoes, railroad supplies and machine equipment and to invest in the reorganization of Roumanian industrial production.

American manufacturers must secure additional outlets for their manufactured production and the great powers of Western Europe will of necessity be forced to adopt a policy limiting the amount of importations, but Roumania desires to secure everything which we can furnish her.

Recent advices indicate that the Roumanian oil production is returning to normal and there will be an opportunity, therefore, to develop a medium of exchange necessary for financing the purchase of American goods.

Turkish Mails

Postmaster Patten in New York has sent out the following announcement: "Articles of mail conforming to the postal union rates, conditions and classification will be accepted for registration when addressed to any place in Turkey in Europe or in Turkey in Asia. Senders who desire their

correspondence, registered or unregistered, delivered through Army Post Office in Constantinople, to be called for by the address, should address the mail Poste Restante. British Army Post Office, Constantinople, Turkey.

The Plight of Roumania

(The Times, London)

Roumania is in need of cereals of every description. Even flour has been imported to feed the inhabitants. The harvest this year will not be a record one, and even that of 1920 may not admit of any export unless it is at the same time possible to import agricultural machinery and fats.

Animal textiles are urgently required, as herds have considerably diminished during the war.

The country wants everything upon which the means of transport depend, especially locomotives and interchangeable pieces; agricultural machinery, ploughs, harrows, tractors, sowing-machines, clothing, boots and shoes. Prices of all commodities and articles are at present exaggerated and abnormal. A costume costs from 1,200 lei to 1,500 lei, a pair of boots 600 lei, a pair of silk stockings 60 lei to 100 lei. Linen sheets, serviettes, pocket-handkerchiefs, and bodylinen of every kind are scarce.

Exporters who can find ready freight to Constantza or Galatz will find a ready market for their goods. With regard to payment, the difficulties are considerable owing to the fact that the present exports from Roumania are insignificant. Exchange is improving, but 100 French francs are still equal to as much as 280 lei. Terms should be short and security satisfactory.

German plan to undertake Baltic-Black sea canal.

(Timber Trades Journal,

London, Apr. 13. 1918)

The Lubeck Chamber of Commerce, after consultation with the Riga Committee, has submitted to the German Government a comprehensive memorial on the plan to connect the Baltic and the Black Sea by canal. By connecting Riga with Kherson petroleum transport from Batum to Hamburg would be shortened by 3,000 kilometere (1,860 miles). It is stated in the memorial that the project of such a canal is not a new idea and that the joining of the Dwina and Dneiper Rivers has long been under consideration in Russia. Before the Russo-Japanese War an English and French syndicate was formed for this purpose, and in 1914 the Russian Government proposals were ready, the Duma allotting 30,000,000 rubles to be spread over five years. It is stated that the waterway would greatly strengthen Russia's ability to take the industrial and commercial products of Germany and the closer economic relations that would arise between Russia and Germany would be of vast political significance. Baltic navigation would be greatly benefited, and the ports of Hamburg and Bremen would be relieved from the strong competition with Dutch and Belgian ports, as the Black Sea trade would be drawn away from the route around Gibraltar. It is advised, finally, that Germany should support Russia financially in this work, which would be undertaken on Russian soil.

According to the Russian Year Book for 1916, the Riga-Kherson canal scheme that had been adopted

in Russia before the war took a depth of 5 feet as the minimum for the canal proper and the regulated river beds. The cost was estimated at 160,000,000 rubles, and the building of the canal was to be divided into three parts: First, the regulation of the Dwina River from Riga to Vitebsk (369 miles); second, the canal proper, from Vitebsk to Orsha on the Dneiper (52 miles); third, the regulation of the Dneiper from Orsha to Kherson (1,049 miles). The total length of the waterway would be 1,470 miles, and at an average speed of 5½ miles per hour vessels would take 12 days to pass the canal. The chief towns situated on the waterway are Riga, Dwinsk, Polotsk, Vitebsk, Mogilev, Kief, Ekaterinoslav, Alexandrovsk, and Kherson. Preliminary work had been undertaken before the war between O-sha and the Black Sea.

Credit in the Balkans

Prospects for American trade in the Balkans have greatly brightened, according to the former Governor-General of Crete, who recently arrived in New York. The stimulation is due to the more liberal policy of payment for goods adopted by United States exporters, and banks handling foreign finances. It has been customary for firms to insist upon full payment for goods before they were shipped, but during the past few months some exporters arranged to execute orders for Greece upon payment in New York of 25 per cent of the bill. The documents are then sent to Greece and the purchaser is drawn upon, through his bank, for the balance of the amount.

Foreign trade of Island of Cyprus.

[British (Government) Board of Trade Journal, May 3.]

According to official returns issued by the chief collector of customs at Larnaca, the value of the merchandise imported into Cyprus in 1916 reached a total of £4,104,350, an increase of £1,451,380, as compared with 1915. The principal items contributing to this increase were flour, cotton piece goods, and coal. The value of the merchandise exports from the colony in 1916 amounted to £3,447,650, as compared with £2,282,045 in the preceding year. The chief gains were in potatoes, mules, sheep, and hides and skins.



Progress of Cyprus.

The trade of Cyprus improved considerably during the first quarter of the year. The exports were two and a half times those of the corresponding period of last year. Efforts are being made to develop still further the wine and spirit industry and to improve the trade in these local products with the United Kingdom.

With this object in view, and to provide for the irrigation of new plantations and a pure water supply, a law has been passed creating a Water Supply Commission at Nicosia, the capital. The Government will be represented by two members on this Commission.

New Electric light installations, tobacco plantations and the manufacture of tobacco are being planned. The acting Governor has granted trading charters to two companies—the Limasol Electric Light Company, and the Pankypriion Tobacco Trading and Manufacturing Company.

The Cyprus Mines Corporation, the registered office of which is in New York, had a contract for building an extension of the Cyprus Government Railways transferred to them in 1916. They have now secured the extension of the contract to May 19, 1920. The transfer to a foreign syndicate of the contract for building a railway in a British Colony has occasioned a good deal of comment.

Agricultural Implements in Palestine.

A recent issue of the British (Government) Board of Trade Journal contains the following extract from a memorandum prepared by the Arab Bureau on the subject of agricultural supplies in Palestine:

In the neighborhood of Jerusalem

a good deal of scientific dry farming is carried on, the ground being kept loose by continuous tillage. The Arabs do not use harrows, but the Jewish colonists have introduced the harrow and the American pulverizer with beneficial results.

The plows chiefly in use in Palestine are the primitive Arab plow and the German plows used throughout the Jewish and German colonies. British plows are said to be too heavy and the shape not quite suitable. In the orangeries and other plantations American plows are used exclusively, and American zigzag harrows are also employed. The use of the American disk harrow is common, and American harvesters are in general use even among the Arabs, while the Jews employ American binders. A hoe made in Philadelphia has been fairly widely introduced, but sowing drills are rare.

In the Jaffa orange district the irrigation of the new groves is effected by means of pumps operated by oil engines. Most of these engines are of British make (3 to 8 horsepower), and it is estimated that there are about 300 of them in the orange groves. There is a great shortage of spare parts. The water is raised by small-bore tubes sunk vertically into the sand strata to a depth of 130 to 200 feet, the water rising to a height of 40 feet in the pipes. The pumps raise from 6,600 to 10,500 gallons per hour. A grove of 20 acres is the minimum economic size for a separate pumping plant. In 1915 the above-mentioned engines were transformed into charcoal-gas engines, as no supplies of oil were available. Of the pumps employed 80 to 90 per cent are of local manufacture, mostly at two factories in Jaffa, one of which is German and the other Jewish where there are a number of good mechanics at work.

Concurrence amicale sur Mer.

A la réunion du Royal Steam Packet Company à Londres, Monsieur Owen Philipps a adressé un speech dont le point principal portait sur la concurrence qui existe entre les Etats-Unis et l'Angleterre au point de vue de la supériorité de la marine marchande. Monsieur Philipps s'exprime comme suit :

"Le monde en général est inquiet de voir l'Amérique après plusieurs années d'abstention reprendre intérêt dans la question de la navigation. Très probablement son abstention provenait du fait que les américains avaient plus d'intérêt à s'occuper de la fertilité de leurs vastes terres que de s'occuper de sa marine marchande. En temps normal la marine marchande ne donnait pas de gros bénéfices.


"Toute la nation américaine, pour défendre l'idéal pour lequel les nations alliées sont entrées en guerre, a consacré son admirable énergie à la construction de chantiers et à la construction de bateaux. L'Angleterre ne manquera jamais de reconnaître et d'admirer cette énergie. Cela a été un exemple merveilleux d'efforts continus pour faire face à une situation des plus dangereuses. Il en est résulté que l'Amérique a aidé d'une façon toute matérielle en tâchant de remplacer dans la mesure du possible le tonnage détruit si illicitemenr par les sous-marins allemands.

"Comme résultat de ces efforts à créer une marine marchande, il se fait que toute la nation américaine se trouve en ce moment on ne peut plus intéressée dans le développement et l'extension de la marine marchande.

"La marine marchande américaine qui en 1914 comptait 2,000,000 de tonnes s'élevait au commencement de cette année à 6,500,000 de tonnes. Il est admis qu'en ce moment les Etats-Unis construisent des bateaux beaucoup plus vite que ne le fait l'Angleterre. Il y a certainement assez de place dans le commerce d'outre mer pour que l'Amérique prenne sa place dans le vide laissé par l'Allemagne, après qu'elle a violé toutes les lois maritimes.

"Les océans et les mers sont libres à tous ceux qui observent les lois maritimes et les lois de l'humanité. L'Angleterre à un moment possédait presque la moitié du tonnage universel, mais j'avoue sincèrement que je salue l'apparition de la nouvelle marine marchande américaine, je lui souhaite tout le succès qu'elle mérite et surtout je fais des vœux pour que notre collaboration soit amicale, chose certainement beaucoup plus facile que cela n'était avec nos ex-concurrents allemands.

"Des changements de tous genres sont à l'ordre du jour, des changements ont lieu partout et rien ne peut faire prévoir si la situation de la marine marchande anglaise redeviendra ce qu'elle était avant la guerre. Les dépenses énormes encourues pour la construction et la réparation des bateaux, l'augmentation des frais pour l'affrètement d'un bateau, sans compter les lourds impôts et les taxes, tout cela va contribuer à conserver pour quelque temps encore des prix très élevés pour les cargaisons et les chargements. D'autres nations ont pris pied dans un commerce qui auparavant appartenait entièrement à l'Angleterre et tout fait prévoir que la concurrence sur mer sera bientôt très sérieuse.

Railway Developments in the Russian Caucasus.

THE British consul at Batum reports that railway construction proceeded apace in the Caucasus in 1916. The Tabriz-Julfa Railway, with its branch from Sofian to Sheref-khani on lake Urumiah, was completed and opened to traffic about the middle of the year. The Shahtahti-Maku-Bayazet, or Alashkert Railway was also working as far as Bayazet before the close of the year. This line is now being extended southward in the direction of Lake Van. The Batum-Trebizond Railway was begun about August, 1916, and by the end of the year work on several sections of the railroad was reported to be advancing favorably. The Baku-Julfa or Araxes Valley Railway progressed fairly rapidly, and much work in connection with earthworks and bridging was completed. Progress was also made during the year with the work on the Novo-Senaki-Sukhum section of the Black-Sea Coast Railway, which is to join the Tuapse-Armavir line at Tuapse.

The question of the construction of an electric railway over the main Caucasian chain, Vladikavkas-Tiflis, received much attention both at Petrograd and at Tiflis. It was tentatively decided to build the line at the close of the war. Another scheme that was constantly before the authorities both at the Russian capital and in the Caucasus, was the construction of a railway from Batum through Artvin and Kars to Julfa. It was definitely decided to place this work in hand immediately after the war.

It is expected on very justifiable grounds that when the projected Railways are completed Batum will become one of the most important ports on the Black Sea. The Batum-Kars Railway will greatly facilitate

the dispatch of over-sea goods to northern Persia and will tap a country rich in mineral wealth and agricultural products. The Trebizond-Batum line will greatly assist to develop the district between the two points mentioned, which contains vast copper and other ore deposits, and where oranges, lemons, and a large variety of fruit, besides other agricultural products, grow in great abundance. The Black-Sea coast line will also help to bring large quantities of merchandise to and from Batum in transit for other parts of Russia. The importance of the existing Baku-Batum line is already well known. Batum is an entrepot for all over-sea merchandise intended for consumption in the Transcaucasus, the Transcaspian district, Russian Central Asia, and northeastern Persia. Considerable quantities of agricultural and animal products are sent to Batum from these regions and are shipped thence for Russian, Mediterranean, United Kingdom, and Continental ports.

The Silk Industry in Bulgaria.

(*Consul General D. I. Murphy, Sophia*)

The first silk factory in Bulgaria was established at Stanimaka about 1888. The modest capital invested, which was entirely American, was insufficient, and after struggling for a few years the establishment was forced to close. At that time spun silk had to be imported, the silkworm, the culture of which had been a prosperous industry in Bulgaria for a century, having become practically extinct from the ravages of the pebrine.

Other factories started up later with more success, keeping pace with the revival of silkworm culture.





These establishments, three of which are located at Adrianople and two at Dimotika, have enjoyed a fair degree of prosperity. They turn out a good quality of silk, which is almost entirely disposed of in the home market. There is every reason to believe that with sufficient capital and the application of modern methods of production the silk industry of Bulgaria would become a most profitable industry.

The conditions are most favorable for raising silkworms—an ideal climate and splendid groves of mulberry trees covering many miles of territory. Besides, the Government gives an annual subsidy to the grower of 53 for every hundred mulberry trees and has established special courses of study in the silkworm culture at the National Gymnasia at Vratza and Sadovo. It has likewise established cocoon markets at Philippopolis, Tatar-Pazardjik, Adrianople, Svilan, Xanthi, Soflu, Dimotika, Vratza, and several other places, and it is announced officially that the Agricultural Bank (under Government control) will purchase vast quantities of cocoons this year. It is likewise officially announced that the Government in its anxiety for the development of the silkworm industry will proceed to take possession of all private mulberry groves that are found upon inspection to be improperly cared for and will install custodians who thoroughly understand modern methods of culture.

In 1878, the year of Bulgaria's liberation, over 5,000 one-ounce boxes of silkworm eggs were produced. The amount had increased in 1907 to 26,649 boxes, in 1909 to 61,367, and in the present year, from January 1 to March 31, 48,000 boxes have been the output. As for the cocoons it has been ascertained that the production in 1887 was 280,000 kilos, valued at 700,000 leva (\$134,619); in 1897, 500,000

kilos, valued at 1,000,000 leva (\$192,308); and in 1907, 2,000,000 kilos, valued at 5,000,000 leva (\$961,540). Since that year the annual production has averaged 2,500,000 kilos valued at 10,000,000 leva (\$1,923,080). From official reports it is ascertained that fully 50,000 families are supported, at least in part, by the cocoon industry.

La Situation Critique de l'Europe

La question des besoins de l'Europe pour des capitaux va, pour quelques années encore être des plus sérieuses. Les Etats-Unis d'Amérique doivent placer en Europe au moins assez de capitaux pour balancer les intérêts qui lui sont déjà dus par l'Europe, intérêts qui représentent approximativement un demi milliard de dollars par an. Pendant ces premières années l'exportation de l'Europe ne pourra seulement que balancer l'importation qui se fera d'Amérique. Si l'Amérique ne place pas de nouveaux capitaux en Europe, celle-ci se trouvera dans une situation des plus pénibles, situation qui rejaillira sur l'exportation américaine, car alors l'Europe se verra obligée de n'acheter aux Etats-Unis que le strict nécessaire.

Meubles Américains

Les fabricants américains prévoient que les meubles américains pour bureaux et cabinets seront très demandés sur les marchés Européens. Une campagne d'exportation va être menée avec le concours de la United States Office Equipment Export Association, qui vient d'être organisée.

Cette association dans le commerce d'outre mer révèle une situation des plus intéressante car elle annonce un changement de politique. Des commandes que l'on recevait auparavant comme par hasard seront maintenant recherchées, et les fabricants déclarent que leur indifférence d'autrefois va être remplacée par une très grande activité.

Cuir et Peaux.

Parmi les campagnes menées pour pousser le commerce Américain avec l'étranger, celle menée par la Tanner's Council of the United States à Boston a été la plus importante. Le président du Conseil, Mr. F. A. Vogel a déclaré

que Mr. Norman Hertz doit faire une inspection très étendue en Europe et surtout en Angleterre ; un autre membre doit également être désigné pour faire une pareille inspection dans l'Amérique du Sud, et probablement un troisième inspecteur sera envoyé pour étudier la même question en Extrême Orient. L'activité de l'association comprend aussi la formation d'un comité pour le commerce étranger et la publication d'une revue commerciale, qui publiée en plusieurs langues donnera des détails et des informations concernant le commerce américain des peaux et des cuirs. Cette revue sera envoyée à plus de trois mille négociants en pays étrangers. Il sera également publié des brochures contenant des statistiques et des tarifs sur les cuirs et les peaux ainsi que des informations concernant le crédit des commerçants et négociants étrangers.

The Emery Stone Mines about Smyrna.

(Written for LEVANT TRADE REVIEW by Frank G. Ballard).

ALMOST the only information about Emery Stone, in a published form, is a pamphlet by Mr. Lawrence Smith, an American mineralogist, which was first printed in the American Journal of Science 2nd. Ser. Vol. 7.,283.

This pamphlet gives about all there is to be learned regarding Emery Stone, in any text book that has reached these shores.

It is full of valuable information concerning the Emery deposits of Asia Minor and several of the neighboring islands, and where there are any errors in the conclusions the author draws, they are traceable to lack of practical experience of the working of the mineral and a prolonged experience in its extraction. The date of this pamphlet is July 15th, 1850. Naturally many of the mines now being worked were unknown at the time the pamphlet was written, and not a few of those mentioned have long since been exhausted.

By far the greater part of the Emery Stone mined and shipped at the present time is produced by the Abbotts Emery Mines Ltd. and comes from many different places in the district of the Ottoman Aidin Railway.

Some of these mines are near the railway and others are far from it; often requiring transportation by camel or donkey over a mountainous and broken country, for many hours. Smyrna is the shipping port for all Emery Stone mined near the railway. The port of Kuluk, two hundred miles south of Smyrna, is the point of departure for great quantities of Emery taken from mines far from the railway. In this district cables had been bought and towers erected, inaugurating a wire causeway for transporting mineral from far in the interior, when the war broke out. The work thus begun will soon be under way again and when completed will make possible the shipment of enormous quantities of Emery.

The Kuluk mines are practically inexhaustible. The railway mines worked by the Abbotts Company are Gelat, Kos Bunar, Ayassoulouk, Azizieh, Baladjik, Kemer, Aidin, Thera and Kouyoujak. Other mines whose ore is shipped from Kuluk are at Kosagatch, Nebikeui, Kaya Bashi, Kestandjik and Ismail Dagh. There are other and smaller properties in this district, whose output is insignificant. There are enough independent Emery Mines in Asia Minor to make competition but there is no doubt that the mines producing the best quality of abrasive have all been bought up by the Abbotts Company.

It may be of interest to state that the Emery Stone which has been most prized and even eagerly bought by consumers was produced by one of the Greek islands called Naxos. This mineral is easily distinguished from Asia Minor Emery both by its color and general appearance. In Naxos however there are three mines, one good and two bad. To experts it has always been a puzzle why buyers pay such a high price for Naxos stone when it has no corresponding increase in actual abrasive properties. All three varieties of Naxos stone contain large percentages of Magnetic Iron, varying between 26 and 37% absolutely useless from an abrasive point of view. There is an Asia Minor Emery which beats the best Naxos, by 50 points. Carefully tested the results follow:

Stone from this mine is the finest Emery known and it abrasivity is only surpassed by Canadian Corrundum which stands at 392 Points.

At one time Naxos stone was taken as standard and the best Asia Minor stone at that time was «Sarakeui», which stood at 300 Points.

In ten samples taken from ten different mines the abrasive value varies from fifty points the lowest, to three hundred and eighty, the highest. The original first quality Sarakeui Emery mine has been exhausted for several years, and there is nothing to replace it of the same high quality but the mine of Kadikeuy which produces the best and strongest Emery now known.

So far as the manufacturers of the various Emery powders, and «Grain Emery» are concerned, many of them are hide bound by tradition and those who know what an Emery ought to be are astonished by their prejudices and what may justly be termed their ignorance of the material they are working with. Emery stone has been called REFUSE and declined by buyers, which was the finest Emery in the world.

Two samples of this stone were sent to America for analysis and they gave respectively 79 and 81 per cent of Alumina Oxide and 395 comparative Points. But they had the ugliest appearance imaginable. So ugly indeed that the best judge of crude Emery in Smyrna and a man of thirty years experience in the Emery trade pooh-poohed them as worthless. This engineer of that particular mine however was convinced of its value before testing, by the lacerations of the fingers of his workmen who cleaned the stone. The error was however excusable as the stone was really exceptional in its characteristics. Speaking generally a lump of Emery stone (if of good sound quality) will stand a heavy blow with the hammer unless the blow is struck on a projecting corner or angle. The stone just referred to however, even in a massive lump, broke up as if it were a lump of glass.

In the early times of the Emery trade and export there were customers who insisted on having Red coated Emery and made the color a sine qua non. At that time, before the mines had been well opened out, the bulk of the Emery shipped consisted of stone which had been exposed for a great many years to rain and wind and weather. This was collected from the field in the immediate neighborhood of the mines. Some of it was RED STONE and some was BLACK. Now as the RED stone was worth much more than the BLACK what was the natural result? The BLACK stone was painted red and became "RED" stone. The buyers were much pleased with the goods and asked for more of the same, continuing to pay a higher price for the RED stone because they believed it to be genuine Abbotts Emery.

It can not be too strongly impressed on Emery buyers that Emery stone, where it has not been exposed to the action of air and water, either as rain, or the water percolating through the load, is GRAY in color. The REDNESS comes from the decomposition of the Magnetic Oxide of Iron which it always contains. It would appear that there is but slight decomposition of the Emery itself. The result of the decomposition is a Red clay which is very sticky and adheres strongly to the stone. It is so adhesive that it takes a great deal of time and labor to remove it even with a scrubbing brush. Stone which has been painted red, is again rendered black or dark gray by a slight shower of rain.

From the foregoing it will be understood that color is no criterion of Emery Stone. If it comes from a gallery driven on to the seam through or under the overburden of mountain limestone, it will be GRAY; if the limestone is impervious to water but if there are fissures through which the water can percolate to the

Emery seam, it will be more or less red coated. The reason that much of the Emery exported today is RED, arises from the fact that the mines from which it comes have been relieved from their over burden of limestone by the weathering process of centuries and the underlying Emery exposed to wind and water, with consequent oxidation of the iron therein.

It is noteworthy that exposure to the air has a decided influence on the color of the stone itself. Emery which has been taken from the mine and chipped, was very distinctly pale blue, and this same Emery after a few days exposure to the sun and air became gray.

Judging of the value of an Emery by the appearance is a work for a tyro, and it takes years of practical experience in the chipping and subsequent examination of the fractured edge, before one is in a position to give an immediate and trustworthy estimate of the quality.

The selection of the stone to form the different grades demands an experienced and practiced eye which only years of actual chipping and selection can give. Recurring to the NAXOS stone, it is worth while to point out, that the operators mix the produce from all the mines together and thus are injuring the quality of the stone and reputation of the mine. Hence the complaints of American buyers and the swelling of the Emery export trade of Turkey till it reaches many thousand tons per year, nearly all of which comes from the Abbotts Emery Mines.

This Company is under the able direction of Mr. E. A. Magnifico, an American Citizen and former Vice Consul who has succeeded in combining the business formerly carried on by the late Mr. E. F. Abbott (as successor to his father who was pioneer of the Asia Minor Emery industry) with the interests of several other mine owners thus forming a flourishing company. Their engineers and chemists have examined samples from every known mine in Asia Minor but buyers do not rely upon, or ask for analyses of the Emery stone they order. Emery is not sold on a percentage base of metals as in the case of Chrome and Manganese.

The reason for this is not far to seek. A manufacturer who has been accustomed to a stone from some particular mine demands the same quality and hesitates to take stone from another Emery mine, because it might mean the necessity of changing the temper of all his tools.

Sometimes the new Emery would be harder and the tools themselves would chip, or may be knock up, like pieces of lead. The appearance of the stone would give no indication and the manufacturer would be unable to detect the difference until he started working it. It is therefore essential that the manufacturer should be able to depend on the miners to give him the same quality each shipment.

The transport of Emery to the Railway or nearest shipping port is done by camels mostly for long distances, and by mules and donkeys where the load has to be carried for three or four hours only.

The load for a camel is from three to four hundred weight, while that for mules is about two cwt. and donkeys one cwt. The price paid varies considerably according to the demand for transport. Before the war it averaged from four to twelve piasters per hundred weight, according to distance.

In conclusion it may be pointed out that the testing of Emery stone is the determination of its actual capacity for wearing down a slab of glass of known weight, by rubbing with a small quantity of water and a weighed quantity of Emery Stone and continuing the rubbing until there is no further loss in weight of the glass slab.

The loss in milligrammes is the "Point" value of the stone under examination, and the Points show the work it will do as compared for instance to corundum

of known efficiency and "Point". If the trial is made invariably with the same slab of glass and the same size of „Grain Emery“, this test is both practical and conclusive.

It may be taken as actual fact that by far the larger proportion of Emery Stone exported from Asia Minor at the present time comes from what should be called quarries: Open quarries exposed to the air and wind and rain from one year's end to the other. The proportion of mineral extracted from real mines worked by galleries under or through limestone rock is very small. That is why the great bulk of Emery shipped is red coated. Therefore buyers of Emery should beware of valuing an Emery stone by its color.

Serbian Developments

BELGRADE, June 15 (by mail).— Plans are being formulated here to utilize the money sent home or brought home from the United States by natives of Jugo-Slavia to enable this country to purchase goods in the United States or elsewhere.

To accomplish this, steps are being taken to organize a General Co-operative Federation. A convention for that purpose soon will be held in Belgrade. It is proposed to unite in this federation fourteen co-operative unions already existing in Serbia, Slovenia, Croatia and Dalmatia. Each union is composed of smaller units known as «zadruga», or loan associations which exist in all branches of industry.

The largest among the fourteen unions is the Federation of the Serbian Farmers' Co-operative Societies. Altogether the unions have a total membership of 400,000 heads of families, corresponding to about 2,000,000 persons.

If the general federation of these fourteen unions is accomplished it is proposed to establish a central bank at Belgrade. This is considered the most practical effort yet made to re-establish credit in Jugo-Slavia. The new federation would sell products and purchase for all its members,

introduce modern machinery, gather the savings of emigrants and aid the farmers to cultivate the land. It is intended to be not political but economic, and might easily be the most powerful institution of Jugo-Slavia.

I. F. Lupis Vukic, of Dalmatia, a banker, who lived for many years in America, is the author of the federation plan. He said that he expected 290,000 of the nearly 1,000,000 Jugo-Slavs in the United States to return to their homes here, bringing American push and the money they have earned in the United States.

«The money sent home by immigrants will be paid to home people in domestic currency», he said. «American money deposited with the federation will be used as buying power abroad. If we organize the money of the Jugo-Slavs in the United States who intend to return, we shall obtain a fund of between 500,000,000 and 1,000,000,000 francs. The needs of the country are great in agricultural machinery, shoes, clothing and all kinds of iron domestic utensils».

With American railway material arriving and American army engineers in the Balkans there is now a prospect that railway conditions in the Near East may soon be bettered. Heretofore the work of rebuilding the thousands of dynamited bridges and of repairing the hundreds of miles of twisted, upturned track in Serbia has progressed slowly.

Serbian railroad engineers have been handicapped by lack of labor and material. At present it is a matter of from ten to fifteen days to cross Serbia from Saloniki to Belgrade. If one link of the motor truck service breaks down because of washed out roads or floods carrying away bridges the whole work of the American Red Cross, the American Food Administration and the Serbian Relief Fund workers is held up and a through journey to Belgrade or Saloniki across country may require from 15 days to a month.

American importers, however, should not figure on transporting freight overland through Serbia at this time. Railroads probably will not be regularly running until early in 1920. Belgrade is best reached via Trieste and Fiume or via Galatz and the Danube rather than from Saloniki.

American shippers will find the harbors and docks at Piraeus (Athens) at Saloniki and Constantinople crowded with freight.

At Piraeus thousands of tons of Newfoundland codfish which were rotting on the docks have been thrown into the ocean to make room for more urgent freight. With the Greek army still in the field there is a great shortage of labor throughout Greece

Roumanian Crops

*Written for Levant Trade Review

Braila, Roumania*

It is gratifying to note that, notwithstanding the immense damage done to land and country during the four years of the terrible war, Roumania, within nine months from the cessation of war is able to produce a crop which will not only amply cover all its food and fodder requirements, but also be in a position to offer to the world market a surplus of nearly 500,000 tons of wheat, barley, rye, oats and seed in addition to a very good maize crop, which it is estimated will yield over one million tons and

consequently have for exportation about half a million tons. This, when taking into consideration the comparatively small area of land, which Roumania was able to cultivate last autumn and during the spring of this year, owing to lack of labor and agricultural implements, is a splendid feat in itself and shows once more the immense richness of the soil of the land. There is hardly any doubt whatever, that Roumania will with a little help from its friends quickly regain the position which it held previous to the war in the Balkans, both as regards finance and commerce in general.

Export statistics during the three years preceding the war according to the „Roumanian Exporter” show the following figures:

5,390,280 Tons representing a value of Lei 691,720,408 in 1911
4,326,735 Tons representing a value of Lei 642,103,873 in 1912
4,569,076 Tons representing a value of Lei 670,705,335 in 1913

In the above export figures, Belgium participate with 38.09% in 1911, with 23.83% in 1912 and with 27.14% in 1913.

Austro-Hungary:
2.09% in 1911, 14.76% in 1912 and 14.23% in 1913.

Italy:
7.16% in 1911, 18.85% in 1912 and 10.63½ in 1913.

France 7.07% in 1911, 7.21% in 1912, 19.47% in 1913.

Germany 4.77% in 1911, 6.62% in 1912 and 7.81% in 1913.

Exportation for England was the least important and only reached the figure of 45 million in value, during the three years.
