Levant Trade Review

Direct Steamship Service.

IT is with much gratification we inform our members that the struggle long sustained by the Chamber for direct and regular steamship service between the United States and the Levant is being crowned with success as shown by the following information received from New York.

I

A joint service of the Ellerman, Bucknell and the Ellerman-Wilson lines from New York to the Levant will be inaugurated on June 26, when the Steamship Aleppo will sail from New York direct to Piraeus and other ports in the Near East. Norton, Lilly & Company and Sanderson & Son will act as joint agents for the line, which will be called the American—Mediterranean—Levant Line. It is the intention of the operators to maintain a monthly service with more frequent sailings if the tonnage offered warrants.

The only significance that may be attached to the starting of the line with the two companies as joint agents is that of "co-operation." Norton, Lilly & Company are the representatives of the Ellerman, Bucknell Line in the United States and Canada, whereas Sanderson & Son served as agents for the Ellerman-Wilson Line in England, where a service

from Hull to the Levant and Black Sea ports has been maintained for a great many years.

Before the war caused the American-Levant Line to suspend its line from New York to the Levant, Norton, Lilly & Co., served as its agent. It was the only service regularly maintained from New York at that time.

According to the present plans, the agents will send out one steamer of about 10,000 tons monthly, affording direct shipment of cargo to Piraeus, Smyrna, Constantinople, Constanza, Galatz, and other Levant and Black Sea ports.

II

In line with its policy of expansion the Cunard Line announced in New York the purchase in England of four new cargo carriers and the inauguration of a new freight service to the Levant. The acquisition of ships included three steel steamers of the 9,600-ton deadweight capacity and one of the 8,500 deadweight type. The three larger cargo carriers will bear the names of Vardulia, Vasconia and Virgilia. The smaller ship will be called the Verbania.

During the war the great English company acquired the business of the American-Levant Line, which formerly operated between New York and ports in the Near East. Owing to the fact that the company's ships

were taken over by the British Government, the operations were necessarily suspended. Now that conditions are returning to normal, the Cunard Line has decided to resume this service. The River Orontes, a 7,000-ton deadweight cargo carrier, has just been released from the control of the British Government and now is due to arrive in New York. She will take on cargo for Piraeus, Salonica, Smyrna, and Constantinople. The River Araxes, which has been in the Government service operating from Italian ports, will sail from New York about the end of June. It seems probable that at least a monthly service will be inaugurated, and there is a possibility of more frequent sailings.

III

Application has been made to the U. S. Shipping Board by a newly established shipping company, the Independent Shipping Corporation, for the allocation of vessels with which to develop an additional American trade route between the United States and Palestine and Egypt. The American terminal of the proposed route would be New York.

Although Shipping Board officials admitted that the application from the ship company had been received and is before the Board for consideration and official action, they refused to divulge the number of vessels requested for the establishment of the new trade route or any other particulars of the proposed shipping enterprise. Definite details of shipping arrangements for the shipment to and from Palestine and Egypt by the United States would be withheld until some action actually had been taken by the Board.

IV

The Van Praagh Steamship Line, Inc., 42 Broadway, New York City, is advertising a regular service to

Alexandria, Beirut and Constantinople. The first steamer of this line, the S. S. Hudson Maru, has already reached Constantinople.

V Later

The establishment of another cargo liner service from New York to Constantinople and Black Sea ports for immediate operations has been announced by the U. S. Shipping Board. The S. S. HUACHUCA, of 7,300 deadweight tons, was allocated to ply in this trade. She will be followed by the S. S. POLYBIUS, of 10,000 tons, to sail in July.

VI

The Independent Steamship Corporation, above referred to, 6 Hanover Street, New York City, announces its new American flag service from New York to the Levant (Tripoli in Africa, Alexandria, Port Said, Beirut, Alexandretta, Smyrna and Constantinople). Its first sailing, scheduled for July, was to be the S. S. WAUCONDA.

American Foreign Trade Corporation.

As announced in the June issue, 1919, of LEVANT TRADE REVIEW (in one of our French articles), the American Foreign Trade Corporation has just been incorporated in Virginia with an authorized capital of \$20,000,000 to develop trade with the Near East. The charter is broad, permitting of varied operations, the center of which in the foreign field will be established in Constantinople, to which port representatives of the Company are already en route. Branch offices will be set up in Smyrna, Armenia, Syria and the Black Sea territory.

The new company, which has been organized under the auspices of the Tobacco Products Corporation, and a number of other merchandising firms in America will have \$5,000,000 7 per cent convertible preferred stock, \$1,000,000 managers' shares and \$14,000,000 commonstock, none of which will be offered for public subscription at this time. Purchase of control in the company has already been effected by the Tobacco Products Corporation and affiliated interests, who are understood to represent George J. Whelan.

The business of the company will be conducted on a barter and trade basis, the plan being to ship samples and stocks of merchandise to the Near East, and to charge manufacturers a commission for acting as their agents. The goods obtained from the

manufacturers will be paid for in New York in dollars, it is said, the merchandise subsequently being bartered for tobacco and other raw materials in the Near East. In this way, cargoes on both the outward and return voyages will be assured and the exchange difficulties eliminated.

The company is designed to aid the interests of the American tobacco manufacturers at the same time that it provides a medium for export trade in the Near East. The understanding is that through affiliation with shipping interests it can command all the tonnage that it will require. The first vessel of the company was scheduled to leave New York about May 20th and the present intention is to follow it with other ships on regular sixty-day intervals. Later, as the business develops, this schedule may require amplification.

Henry M. Day, head of the Henry M. Day, Inc., is president, the other officials being George A. Harder, president of the Iron Products Corporation, vice president; William H. Butler, of Butler Bros., second vice president; George L. Storm, vice president of the Tobacco Products Corporation, third vice president; John Jeffries, treasurer of the Tobacco Products Corporation treasurer and William A. Ferguson, secretary.

All of the above are directors, and Mr. Storm is chairman of the board. Other directors are: Ernest Bull, of the Bull Steamship Company; F. J. Castelli, of the Oriental Carpet Company; R. M. Ellis and George Sumner, and other captains of industry.

The Wealth of Greece

(*The Times, London*)

In a letter which has just been received from Athens a business man gives a glowing account of the prosperous conditions apparent in all the large towns of Greece. He says that there appears to be a great accumulation of wealth in every business centre, and that money is being spent lavishly.

With regard to possible trade openings for the British manufacturers he points to the great scarcity of electric equipment of all kinds from dynamos to fittings. The latter, he adds, should be of the screw pattern and not of the bayonet type. All office equipment is assured of a good sale. An ordinary office typewriter costs anything up to £ 50; stationery is very scarce, and 4s. is charged for a packet of very inferior envelopes. There is also a great shortage of printing machinery, the printers being in great need of renewing stock which they have had no opportunity of acquiring since the war. He adds that it is proposed to expend 6,000,000 drachma on improving the telephone system, and that in connection with the important housing scheme sanitary appliances are in very great demand.

The above is a confirmation of the statement that Greece and indeed, most of the Levant, is absolutely bare of every kind of manufactured goods. The simplest and cheapest articles are almost unobtainable at any price. To quote but one example: a business man in Greece recently needed an inkpot, just an ordinary glass inkpot with a metal lid. After searching Athens for four days, his dragoman at length produced a cheap moulded glass bottle with no lid, and the price was 4.50 francs. But though bare of goods, Greece herself is full of money. It is estimated that at the present moment she has a surplus of over £ 60,000,000 beyond her present wealth, which is literally burning a hole in her pocket. The Greek is a merchant first and last, and unless he can buy and sell he is utterly miserable. There was never before such an opening for British manufacturers, but they must seize the opportunity while it exists, for if not other countries, such as the United States of America, will enter the field, and once established there, it will be very difficult to displace them.

While only pre-war statistics are available, it is well to bear in mind that to-day the situation has altered considerably and all in our favour. Germany and Austria, our chief rivals, not only

cannot supply Greece with goods, but for over four years have been similarly prevented from trading with her; nor has any other country arisen who was able to take their places. Therefore, practically the whole Greek trade can pass into our hands, and if some of our manufacturers are surprised to hear how empty she is, it will only be necessary to remind them of this fact: For several years there has been a large foreign army on her soil, which has bought up at famine prices everything available, and hardly anything has been coming into the country owing to the manifold difficulties caused by the war.

Interest in Roumania

(Correspondence from New York to "The Times", London)

Keen interest has recently been aroused in Roumania as a field for United States exports. Few actual steps have been taken toward promoting American trade there, however, for up to very recently the unstable political conditions, an unfavorable rate of exchange and the problem of arranging credits gave little encouragement to projected enterprise in the Balkan country. But the report that oil production has been partly renewed, despite chaotic conditions, started action among American manufacturers of oil well supplies who had sold in good volume to Roumania before the war; one of these concerns has already sent two representatives overseas to resume business operations as soon as conditions permit.

It is also reported that the United States Department of Commerce has sent a trade commissioner to Roumania and two American steamship companies are seeking information in connection with the contemplated establishment of shipping lines to the Black Sea. If this shipping service develops it will probably be organized so that ships will call at Constanza and other Black Sea ports, unload American merchandise, and take a Roumanian cargo of cereals or other products, delivering them at European ports, where goods could be loaded for consumption in the United States. Some such arrangement would be required, as there is practically no demand in the United States for Roumanian products. A former member of the American diplomatic service in Bucharest holds the view that the Roumanian interests would grant concessions to Americans and are eager to form cooperative enterprises for the development of railroads, water power, and oil lands.

Bois de Construction Américain.

CELA étonnera beaucoup de monde d'apprendre que les Etats-Unis d'Amérique possèdent, exception faite de la Russie d'Europe, de la Russie d'Asie et du Canada, le plus vaste aréage de bois de construction n'exportait jusqu'à présent que le huit pour cent de ses coupes annuelles ; le reste ayant toujours été employé à l'intérieur du pays pour transformer des villages en villes et des villes en cités.

Pour faire face à toutes les demandes intérieures les commerçants et les négociants en bois de construction n'ont jamais eu le temps de s'occuper d'un commerce d'exportation. Toutefois pendant la guerre les américains intéressés dans le commerce du bois de construction ont entrevu la possibilité de trouver en Europe des marchés d'importation pour le bois de construction américain et depuis de grandes sommes ont déjà été dépensées pour étudier ces marchés. Des représentants du commerce américain ont fait de longs séjours en Europe et ont rapporté à leurs chefs que tout fait prévoir que des grandes demandes pour des bois de construction seront adressées en Amérique dès que le travail de reconstruction commencera en Europe.

En Amérique les différentes branches du commerce en bois de construction ont déjà préparé leurs voies pour l'exportation sur une grande échelle, leurs efforts ont été soutenus et facilités par la loi entitlée "Webb-Pomerene Act". On dit qu'une grande corporation patronnée par des négociants millionnaires vient d'être organisée, cette corporation aurait pour but de fournir à la France et à la Belgique tout le bois de construction qui leur sera nécessaire. On dit aussi que le plan qui existait pour une association d'exportation sous la loi Webb

vient d'être terminé grâce à l'influence des négociants en bois de pins des Etats du Sud. Cette association sera connue sous le nom de "American Pitch Pine Export Company" avec un capital minimum de 2,000,000 de dollars. On croit que plus de 50 usines et fabriques prendront part à cette association et donneront un capital réuni de plus de 250,000,000 de dollars avec une capacité productive d'à peu près 4,000,000,000 de pieds de planches.

Canals Proposed

The following is clipped from the columns of THE NEAR EAST, London :

I see that it is proposed to supplement communications between Western Europe and the Near East by the construction of a series of waterways connecting the Danube with the French rivers. The project is one which naturally makes a strong appeal to France in view of that country's considerable interests in the Near East, and it is to be expected that every effort will be made in that quarter to carry the scheme through. The preliminary negotiations are evidently already well advanced, as the various governments concerned are stated to be appointing commissions to study the question. It is stated that a canal between the Upper Danube and Lake Constance will be the central link in the scheme, and that from the lake a new route will lead to the Rhine.

L'opium en Amérique.

D'AMMI les nombreux arrivages qui viennent d'avoir lieu à New York figurent 610 caisses d'opium. Cette marchandise est arrivée en deux cargaisons et est adressée à différents consignataires. Les prix de l'opium sont tels, qu'aujourd'hui une seule de ces cargaison représente à peu près un million de dollars. C'est le premier arrivage d'opium de Turquie, depuis 1914, époque où toutes les communications maritimes avaient été arrêtées à cause de la guerre, ce premier arrivage de drogue a pour ainsi dire quelque peu bouleversé le marché.

Jusqu'à présent tout l'opium nécessaire à la fabrication des narcotiques si utiles pendant la guerre venait de la Perse et des Indes, mais la qualité n'a jamais égalé celle des anciennes marques turques.

Maintenant que le blocus avec la Turquie est levé, tout fait prévoir que la Turquie va de nouveau fournir tout l'opium dont l'Amérique a besoin, d'autant plus que suivant les meilleures sources à New York on dit que le commerce de l'opium va beaucoup diminuer et va devenir moins important que ce qu'il était avant la guerre. Une ère nouvelle va commencer aux Etats-Unis qui va porter directement sur la distribution et la consommation des narcotiques.

Le représentant d'une grande droguerie américaine s'exprime de la façon suivante :

« Ces derniers arrivages d'opium représentent un grand stock pour lequel il faudra de nouveaux acheteurs, mais quel seront ces acheteurs, voilà ce que je me demande. Quant à nous, nous employons l'opium pour la fabrication de nos narcotiques, mais nous n'avons aucune sympathie pour ce que l'on appelle le commerce de l'opium, cela

est l'opinion et l'avis de tous les droguistes en général.

« Depuis des années nous nous sommes toujours approvisionnés aux mêmes sources ce qui fait que nous savons d'où vient notre opium et avec qui nous avons à faire. Pendant la guerre il nous a été impossible de nous approvisionner sur ces marchés, mais maintenant qu'ils nous sont ouverts à nouveau, nous comptons reprendre nos travaux avec eux. Très probablement les autres fabricants de produits pharmaceutiques à base d'opium feront la même chose. Maintenant que le commerce de l'opium ne jouit plus d'une très bonne réputation, il va beaucoup diminuer et par conséquent être très limité. Ce qui va surtout le limiter se sont les lois mises en vigueur par le gouvernement américain.

« Pendant la guerre l'armée faisait une grande consommation de narcotiques. Il y avait des millions d'hommes sur les champs de bataille et tous les hommes étaient munis de morphine. Mais il faut aussi affirmer que l'on a pas abusé de l'emploi de la morphine et que la crainte que nous pouvions faire des morphinomanes de nos soldats n'a jamais eu de fondement.

« En tous cas, pour ce qui est de la distribution et de l'emploi de l'opium, les autorités gouvernementales avec lesquels nous travaillons en parfaite harmonie n'ont aucun sujet d'inquiétude. Seules les autorités municipales s'inquiètent à tort, car l'habitude des narcotiques est en train de disparaître, et elle ne pourra certainement pas reprendre tant que le gouvernement s'occupe sérieusement de la distribution des drogues en général.

« Les pharmaciens, les droguistes en gros et au détail désireraient si cela leur était possible ne rien avoir à faire avec l'opium et ses dérivés. Quelque soit la bonne réputation d'une personne, quelque stricte et conscientieuse soit-elle, il se trouvera tou-

jours quelqu'un pour l'accuser d'abus si l'on s'aperçoit qu'elle s'occupe d'opium.

« Cependant nous avons besoin, et grand besoin de cette drogue dans le commerce et tout ce que nous pouvons faire c'est de surveiller attentivement à ce que l'opium et ses dérivés ne tombent pas entre n'importe quelles mains.

« Les prix de l'opium baissent rapidement. Il n'y a pas longtemps l'opium était coté à 40 dollars le kilo et aujourd'hui il est à 20 dollars le kilo. Il y a trois ou quatre grandes drogueries qui emploient l'opium pour la fabrication de leurs produits pharmaceutiques et ces drogueries importent directement l'opium qui leur est nécessaire. Personne ne peut prévoir quel va être le sort de ces récents arrivages d'opium.

Il paraît que pendant la guerre, tandis que la Turquie ne pouvait rien exporter, tous les petits commerçants d'opium ont acheté de ci et de là une caisse d'opium et de cette façon sont arrivés à avoir un stock assez considérable. Dès que cela leur a été possible ils ont expédié ce stock en Amérique, à un parent, un ami ou un correspondant. Reste à voir si leur entreprise va réussir, d'après les différents compte rendus, il semble que leur spéculation ne sera pas aussi bonne qu'il y avait lieu de l'espérer.

Un Département Américain pour l'Exploitation du Charbon

D'APRÈS les informations reçues dans les différents bureaux d'exportation, il paraît qu'il y a plus de 4,000,000 de tonnes de charbon en souffrance et qui attendent le moment d'être embarquées pour l'étranger. A cause de ce grand tonnage à embarquer et en même temps à cause de toutes les difficultés encourues, il y a eu beaucoup de demandes, de propositions et d'offres faites dans les différents bureaux et départements, il a donc été décidé de créer un bureau spécial au ministère à Washington, bureau qui s'occupera essentiellement de cette correspondance et de l'exportation des charbons américains. Le "Shipping Board" pour coopérer avec la nouvelle association des intéressés dans les charbons, s'est chargé d'assigner dans la mesure du possible les bateaux nécessaires à l'exportation des charbons américains.

Suivant une dépêche de Washington, le nouveau département du "Shipping Board" sera placé sous le contrôle de Monsieur J. H. Rosseter et sera dirigé par Monsieur H. Y. Saint, de Seattle. La même dépêche ajoute que Monsieur Rosseter aurait dit que Monsieur Saint avait l'intention de convoquer un meeting à Washington auquel seraient invités tous les directeurs des centres houillers, tous les producteurs, les exportateurs et les commerçants en charbons, pour discuter la situation, et pour suggérer des idées qui pourraient être favorables au développement du commerce des charbons américains.

"Le Shipping Board, dit Monsieur Rosseter, est très intéressé dans l'exportation du charbon, mais tant qu'une grande partie de notre tonnage est employé pour le service de ravitaillement et de bienfaisance nous n'avons pas suffisamment de bateaux pour faciliter notre commerce houiller. Mais heureusement le moment est venu de faire des plans pour l'avenir en ce qui concerne le développement de ce commerce. Le Shipping Board qui a reconnu l'importance de ce travail a autorisé la formation d'un nouveau bureau pour le répartition des exercices et qui sera connu comme le "Department of Coal Exports".

Un membre du Shipping Board a déclaré qu'il y a plus de 3,000,000 de tonnes de charbon qui doivent être embarquées à New York dès que les bateaux nécessaires à leur transport pourront être obtenus. D'après certains rapports parvenus au Shipping Board



il paraît que les stocks de charbon en Suède et Norvège et en Argentine aussi bien que sur les côtes de la Méditerranée sont épuisés.

A cause des événements actuels et de la possibilité d'une grande exportation en pays étrangers la National Coal Association a fait publier des avis d'après lesquels tous les particuliers sont prévenus qu'il serait prudent de leur part de faire tout de suite leur provision de charbon pour l'hiver prochain vu que dès que les moyens de transport seront assurés il y aura certainement pénurie de charbon sur les marchés américains. L'Association cependant assure que le stock actuel est énorme mais elle prévoit que les demandes étrangères feront pencher la balance en sens contraire.

L'Europe admet qu'elle a un besoin pressant pour du charbon. On dit que l'Italie à elle seule a besoin de 2,000,000 de tonnes tout de suite. On représente la situation comme critique. Les pays scandinaves, la Suède et la Norvège, le Danemark, n'ont aucun stock de charbon, et ils sont décidés à payer n'importe quel prix pour obtenir du combustible. Les régions du River Plate en Amérique du Sud demandent instamment du charbon quelqu'en soit la qualité.

On dit dans les Bureaux du Shipping Board que la plus grande partie des bateaux qui vont être libérés du service de ravitaillement vont servir au commerce du charbon. Il a été aussi remarqué qu'il n'y aura aucune perte de temps car les cargaisons de charbon sont toutes prêtes, cette perte de temps n'aurait pu être évitée si les bateaux en question devaient prendre des cargaisons différentes et variées.

Malgré la grande extension que prend la marine marchande américaine, ce n'est qu'une question de temps pour que presque tous les ports Européens soient desservis par des bateaux battant pavillon américain, le problème qui demande à ce qu'un immense tonnage puisse être transporté reste encore un problème que la marine marchande doit résoudre. On dit que le Shipping Board a l'intention de procurer des lieux d'embarquement pour les bateaux affrétés par les compagnies américaines.

La National Coal Association, dans un rapport, déclare ce qui suit:

"L'industrie houillère des Etats Unis a été pendant plusieurs mois dans l'impossibilité de fournir même une petite partie des millions de tonnes de charbon que les pays étrangers demandaient. Ceci était dû au manque de moyens de transport, tous les bateaux ayant été employés, d'abord à remener les soldats américains dans leur foyer et plus tard à transporter des produits alimentaires en Europe. Pendant ce temps, tandis que tous les pays demandaient du

charbon en Amérique, les Etats Unis ne produisaient que le tiers voir même la moitié de leur production habituelle. La situation aujourd'hui est telle, qu'il va falloir absolument augmenter notre production si nous voulons être en état de pourvoir à nos besoins domestiques, mais cette augmentation de production ne sera obtenue que si l'on a des acheteurs. Les mines ne peuvent exister et ne peuvent fonctionner que si elles ont des commandes à exécuter. Depuis quelques mois, il n'y a pas eu assez d'acheteurs sur les marchés américains, ce qui fait que les centres houillers se sont contentés d'un travail très restreint. Les ouvriers ont quitté les mines et sont allés prendre du travail ailleurs espérant trouver un travail plus continue et plus sûre. Il y a aussi plusieurs milliers de mineurs qui essayent de passer en Europe.

L'apparition d'acheteurs sur les marchés américains permettrait aux centres houillers de reprendre leur travail et de tâcher de faire face, non seulement aux demandes extérieures mais encore aux besoins des Etats Unis pour la prochaine saison d'hiver.

Tout fait prévoir que si les Etats Unis ne parviennent pas à expédier leur stock de charbon, il y aura un manque de combustible dans le monde entier. Aucun autre pays que les Etats Unis ne peut en ce moment faire face aux besoins universels. La production de l'Angleterre a actuellement beaucoup diminué et n'est certainement pas ce qu'elle était avant la guerre. Tout le monde est d'avis qu'il sera matériellement impossible pour l'Angleterre d'extraire tout le charbon nécessaire à l'Europe.

Il faudra de trois à six ans pour que les centres houillers français puissent reprendre leur production d'avant guerre, quant à la Russie la situation semble désespérée. Toutes sortes de difficultés menacent l'industrie houillère allemande, les révoltes, les changements de partis, les dissensions des ouvriers. Il y a aussi paraît-il une grande diminution de production en Australie que l'on aurait pu considérer comme un centre important d'approvisionnement. Il n'y a que l'Espagne dont la production a augmenté pendant la guerre, mais malgré cette augmentation de production l'Espagne ne suffit pas à ces besoins domestiques. L'Italie a une certaine quantité de lignite qui est loin d'être suffisante.

Le monde entier, à l'exception des Etats Unis est donc menacé d'un manque de charbon. Pour éviter cela il faudrait une énorme augmentation de production dans les centres houillers universels. Plus de 100,000,000 de tonnes de charbon pourraient être exportées des Etats Unis avant la fin de l'année, si les bateaux nécessaires à ce transport pouvaient être affrétés. Ces 100,000,000 tonnes ne répondent cependant pas à toutes les demandes adressées aux Etats Unis.»

Persian Tea and Tobacco.

(*The Times, London*)

The war has affected Persia, more especially the northern districts, in a way that is little realized. As never before the productive provinces bordering on the Caspian Sea are open to the European markets.

Until recently Russia was dominant in this part of the world, and looked upon these rich northern provinces as her special preserve, but did little or nothing towards their development.

Gilan, a province on the southern shores of the Caspian Sea, though reaching as far as the Elburz Mountains, is to a very large extent little above sea level. Tobacco and rice are the principal products of this very fertile district.

The tobacco grown is principally used in the manufacture of cigarettes, and differs from that cultivated in the highlands, which is exclusively a pipe tobacco. The cigarette blend is somewhat akin to Turkish, and has the great advantage of not irritating the throat. In normal times Persian cigarettes are sold at 8d. per 100, the unprepared article in comparison being much cheaper. Now that transit difficulties are no longer an obstacle, much of this tobacco ought to find its way into the European market.

Far more important from an economic point of view are the possibilities of tea planting. Probably few, if any, of our planters realize that of recent years tea has been successfully grown quite close to the shores of the Caspian. In flavour it is exquisite, and compares favourably with our better-grade teas. Lahijan, some 30 miles west of Resht, is the centre of this new industry.

In the Gilan province there are acres and acres of virgin forest land waiting to be exploited. The wood in the process of clearing ought to find a ready sale in the various Caspian ports — boxwood is already largely exported. The forest once cleared, tea could be cultivated on a large scale. There would be little difficulty in finding a market for this product, as the Persians themselves are proverbial tea drinkers. Russia, too, is in close proximity, besides which the London market could easily be supplied from Batum.

There is an abundant rainfall in this northern province, and the question of labour would present no difficulty, as both men and women are accustomed to work in the fields, and are not at all adverse to European control.

Even a few small Persian farmers with little initiative and less experience have already proved the possibilities of this new undertaking. Certainly a great future awaits the planters who are ready to expend the necessary capital and labour in this new field. Concessions from the Persian Government would naturally have to be obtained, but little difficulty ought to be experienced.

E Pluribus Unum

NCERTAIN CIRCLES, in cities in the Levant, where Branches of the AMERICAN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE FOR THE LEVANT were established prior to the war, objection is raised to the Branch idea as implying a certain degree of inferiority and of dependence. It is appreciated that co-operation is essential, and co-operation under the banner, as it were, of LEVANT TRADE REVIEW is wanted, but it is pointed out that the American chambers of commerce in cities in the Levant other than Constantinople should be allowed to be known as associates of the mother chamber rather than as Branches or Sections or Chapters thereof.

The Board of Directors has not yet had occasion to bring this matter to a vote as provided by the Articles of Incorporation, the Constitution and the By-Laws adopted in Washington on January 17th, 1916. These documents were framed in the most liberal spirit of self-government, and no obligations rest upon the "Branches" except a purely nominal fee which hardly amounts to a fair subscription price for LEVANT TRADE REVIEW (the latter being mailed gratis to all members), and the stipulation that "Branches" should consist exclusively of local members. Each "Branch" is expected, through its Secretary, to furnish material from time to time to LEVANT TRADE REVIEW, but obviously that is a privilege rather than an obligation.

However, what the Board wants is the most sincere and cordial co-operation throughout the Levant on the part of all business men interested in American dealings, and nothing is further from its intentions than to unduly circumscribe the activities of the chambers which were formed in consequence of the initiative of the Constantinople body some years ago. The Board is more than disposed to abandon the "Branch" system and to accept the suggestion of chambers associated with the original group.

As in the past, these chambers would deal directly with manufacturers and merchants in the United States, not only without any interference on the part of the central organization in Constan-

tinople but also with the latter's warm encouragement, advice and support.

On the other hand, only confusion and failure could result from a campaign of rivalry for membership in the Levant and in America on the part of the chambers in Constantinople, Smyrna, Salonika, Athens, Beirut, Cairo, Sofia, Bucharest, etc., It is, therefore, considered of vital importance that the several chambers associated with the mother organization restrict their membership to local, resident business men.

The AMERICAN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE FOR THE LEVANT will continue and intensify its patriotic work for the extension of American trade and influence in the Levant and the Balkans. It is incorporated in the United States and duly recognized by the American Government and by the Chamber of Commerce of the United States of America. Its record is clean, its career creditable. We heartily welcome into collaboration with us both individual merchants and collective bodies, East and West, whose aims are ours : public-spirited in the American sense and untainted with narrow prejudices. It is immaterial whether the headquarters of the movement is Constantinople or Salonika or some other town within the field of our efforts.

Gentlemen :

La Situation en Asie-Mineure

Une interview du Dr. Barton

On sait que des missions américaines avaient été envoyées dans les différentes régions de l'Anatolie pour y inspecter la situation économique et sanitaire des populations locales. Le chef, le Dr. James L. Barton, de retour de son voyage, vient de fournir les renseignements suivants à un journal à Constantinople.

« Après un pénible, mais fructueux voyage en Anatolie, j'ai pu me faire un tableau exact de la situation dans ces régions éprouvées par une longue guerre. Malgré les grands changements qui se sont produits pendant ces quatre dernières années, la situation n'est pas aussi désespérée qu'on le croit. Ainsi la récolte de cette année promet d'être bonne. Par contre, les conditions sanitaires et hygiéniques du pays sont détestables. Le commerce est presque complètement paralysé. La vie est excessivement chère. Beaucoup d'articles indispensables font complètement défaut. Dans les grands centres de l'Anatolie, à Konia, Césarée, Adana, Samsoun, le calme n'a cessé de régner pendant mon séjour. Les cas de brigandages sont fréquents dans les villages. Les forces gouvernementales appuyées par la population combattent les brigands avec une louable énergie. Quoique des massacres n'aient pas eu lieu, la population chrétienne est vivement alarmée. Elle s'attend aux pires éventualités et vit dans des trances continues.

Des troubles n'ont été signalés jusqu'ici que dans les territoires de l'Anatolie Orientale situés hors du rayon de l'occupation des forces alliées. Les autorités anglaises n'ont pas autorisé jusqu'ici les émigrés arméniens du Caucase à regagner leurs foyers.

Actuellement 300 à 350 Américains sont répartis dans les diverses régions de l'Anatolie où ils essayent de soulager la misère des populations locales. Les Kurdes qui avaient émigré devant l'invasion russe commencent à regagner leurs foyers. Quand aux Arméniens se trouvant dans les territoires placés sous l'occupation anglaise, leur situation est excellente. J'ai pu m'entretenir avec un grand nombre d'entre eux à Damas, Hama et Alep. Ils sont très satisfaits de leur sort et se livrent pour la plupart au commerce.

Nous avons fixé à 5000 tonnes le stock de blé à répartir parmi les habitants des provinces orientales de l'Anatolie. En vue de parer à la pénurie des étoffes, nous avons constitué dix filatures qui sont actuellement en pleine activité. Le ravitaillement de la population des provinces en question nous revient mensuellement à 500,000 dollars. Cette somme sera accrue par la suite. Les difficultés que nous rencontrons dans l'exécution de notre tâche sont considérables. Songez que nous nous trouvons en présence d'un pays entièrement dévasté. Il nous faudra reconstruire des milliers de maisons pour y héberger les émigrés qui refluent de tous les environs. Nous avons demandé à cet effet l'assistance d'une grande société américaine de construction. Elle a répondu chaleureusement à notre appel. En attendant nous poursuivons activement la construction de baraquements en bois et de chaumières.

Les Français et les Anglais ont assumé également leur part dans cette entreprise humanitaire. Les orphelinats arméniens d'Adana, Aïntab, Marasch, Alep, Tarisous et Ourfa, sont entretenus par les soins des alliés.

J'aime à croire que sous peu de temps, nous réussirons à ramener la prospérité dans ces malheureuses régions. La situation du Caucase est beaucoup plus critique que celle de l'Asie-Mineure. Je me rendrai par conséquent sous peu en Arménie turque et en Arménie russe.

Co-operation rather than Competition

At a recent meeting of the Board of Directors of the AMERICAN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE FOR THE LEVANT, Mr. G. Bie Randal, American Commissioner and Consul General in Constantinople, expressed himself approximately as follows:

"I think I voice American opinion correctly in saying that we want co-operation rather than competition: mutual helpfulness among the nations, in order that the world may recover from its present prostration.

"The principal political and economic need of the moment is to get to work and to produce instead of drawing "chomage" rations. In that way only can we overcome the elements of social disintegration which enjoy at present a lurid spell of license in the wake of the war. In that way only can we reestablish industry and commerce and finance upon a solid and enduring basis and ultimately bring back into the millions of homes happiness and prosperity.

"You complain of the fluctuations of exchange and with good reason. There is a lot of cheap fiat money floating about everywhere. In order to steady exchange we must dig in the ground and bore in the mines and hew in the forests; produce that which is equivalent to sound money, i. e. merchandise to be exported.

"As for America, we do not care excessively whether you export these goods, whether to Bombay or to Baltimore. The world will be benefited anyhow, by getting injected into its system fresh and precious life blood. Of this world, every nation is a component part and suffers or benefits proportionnally.

"The world is really in trouble. It would be madness to indulge in the old sort of competition under present conditions. It would be infinitely worse than Nero's fiddling at the burning of Rome.

"The cure for the present ills is work—hard, honest toil. Work is the keynote of the era of reconstruction.

"I trust this Chamber will lend its best efforts to encourage *labor* and *production* in the Levant and the Balkans. Mother nature, our "alma mater" is ever generous. These countries are rich in natural resources. The situation is by no means hopeless."



Agricultural Machinery and Implements in the Levant

A correspondent to The Times, London, writes as follows :

Before the war all efforts which had from time to time been made to introduce modern agricultural implements and machinery into Syria met with poor success.

The attention which has recently been paid to the growing of cotton in the districts round Haifa and the Jordan Valley has, however, created possibilities for the use of machinery, especially steam ploughs, for opening up large tracts of land needed for this special kind of cultivation.

Now that the numbing effect of Turkish rule has been removed the whole situation has been changed, and British manufacturers must be ready to enter the field and demonstrate the advantages of modern machinery. Nor must the possibilities of foreign agricultural concessions be ignored, in which case a very large demand will arise for modern agricultural machinery. But it is well to emphasize the fact that firms desiring to open up a large trade must be prepared to send out competent technical demonstrators, who will show how the machinery should be used and be able to repair it when required.

Conditions similar to those in Syria obtain also throughout Asia Minor. In Greece and the Balkans the people are more advanced and are more ready to accept new ideas, so that while complicated machinery is not required there is already a growing demand for the simpler agricultural machinery, one of the lines most in demand being ploughs.

Major A. R. Hoover, recently elected member of the Board of Directors of our Chamber, has served for years in Turkey as a medical missionary. In 1915 he was in charge of the American Red Cross Hospitals in Constantinople. During the war he became a Major in the Medical Corps of the United States army and saw service in France. On his demobilization Major Hoover was elected Medical Director of Constantinople College which contemplates a medical school for women and a training school for nurses.

Oscar Gunkel, our President, is at present on a visit to Syria and Palestine in the interest of the Standard Oil Company of New York of which he is the General Manager for the Levant.

Dr. Rufus Lane of Smyrna, a pioneer among American merchants in the Near East, has been in Constantinople in behalf of the extension of his trade and shipping relations.

James Finger of the American Tobacco Co., has returned to his duties at Samsoun.

American Banks in the Near East.

The Irving National Bank in New York, one of America's most progressive banking institutions, which is giving special attention to foreign affairs, has arranged to send a representative to the Levant for the purpose of studying conditions and investigating the advisability of establishing permanent personal representation in that section. Gustav de Lerch, who spent many years in the Near East before the war in the Russian diplomatic service, has been chosen for this work, and recently sailed on the Cunard steamer Pannonia to take up his duties. His field will include Greece, Turkey, the Balkan States and the new political units taking shape in Asia Minor.

The question of maritime transportation being now in a fair way of solution, it is incumbent upon every one who has American commercial expansion in the Near East at heart to bend every effort upon the establishment out here of American banks of discount and investment.
